

SUMMARY OF ACHIEVEMENTS OF DR. ROBINSON TOMBARI SIBE, FNSE

Dr Sibe is a globally respected Digital Forensics and Cybersecurity Leader. He has played key roles in cybersecurity consulting and led several complex digital forensic investigations (unable to list here for privacy and security reasons). He has also supported key national institutions in digital forensic investigation, policy contributions, building capacity, cybersecurity readiness, and promoting cybersecurity awareness. He has conducted several high-level consultancy and trainings in Cybersecurity and digital forensic investigation for key national institutions, law enforcement agencies, and others, both in Nigeria and internationally. He was recently Awarded Cybersecurity Personality of the Year 2025 at the Nigeria Cybersecurity Conference, organized by Nigeria Information Technology Development Agency (NITDA), Ministry of Communication, Innovation, and Digital Economy, and the Office of the National Security Adviser (ONSA).

This year (2025), his practice has taken him to several countries including Ghana, Rwanda, Seychelles, Netherlands, Spain, and Thailand. In the last 12-months, he has consulted widely and recognized as a subject matter expert globally. Earlier in the year, he was part of the Commonwealth team of experts that trained the Seychelles CERT and the Criminal Justice Department on Cybercrime Investigation and Digital Forensics. He was also part of the team of facilitators during the Commonwealth Africa Cyber Fellows session, also at Seychelles. He was the lead consultant to TAG International, United Kingdom, for the drafting of the National Digital Forensics Framework for Nigeria (a project for the Office of the National Security Adviser). He was also a consultant to the International Centre for Migration Policy Development (ICMPD), Austria, for Drafting of the Handbook for Cybercrime for Nigeria's Joint Case Team for Cybercrime (JCTC). He also served as lead facilitator to various high impact trainings for Law Enforcement Agencies and other national institutions. He was also the lead trainer for the Commonwealth team and the Federal Ministry of Justice in training on Digital Forensics and Cybercrime Investigation for the Joint Case Team for Cybercrime.

He has been a shining example in the quest to bridge the cyber skills gap in Nigeria and beyond. He currently volunteers (pro bono) to teach Cybersecurity and Incident Response and supervise Masters and Ph.D Projects at the National Open University of Nigeria. Last year, he founded the Cyber Skills Bridge Fellowship and hit the ground running with a free 3-months intensive training on cybersecurity and digital forensics to 20 Fellows. Some of the fellows were drawn from law enforcement and the military. He has also conducted free trainings for some key national institutions, as part of corporate social responsibility.

Dr. Sibe is a model Cybersecurity Professional, with a rich blend of experience in both the industry and the academia. He was also recently appointed a Professor of Practice of Cybersecurity at the MIVA Open University. He is also an Advisory Board Member of the University of the Cumberland, USA, Ph.D Information Technology Programme, in recognition of his expertise in Cybersecurity and Digital Forensics. He has also served in similar role (visiting/guest) at the Center of Cybersecurity and Forensic Education (C2SAFE), Illinois Institute of Technology, USA. He also currently serves as a Visiting Fellow of the University of South Wales, in recognition of his global expertise in Cybersecurity and Digital Forensics. He also serves as a Dissertation Chair (Cybersecurity) of Capitol Technology University, Maryland, USA. He also lectures at the Computer Engineering Department of Rivers State University. He continues to contribute to several universities, in Nigeria and internationally, and is widely respected for his solid contribution to the body of knowledge.

Dr. Sibe serves as the CEO/Lead Forensic Examiner of Digital Footprints Nig. Ltd, where he continues to lead brilliantly to global acclaim, leading complex digital forensics projects, and mentoring a new generation of cybersecurity experts. He manages a state-of-the-art digital forensic laboratory in Abuja, Nigeria. Last year, he published the globally respected book: Cybercrime, Digital Forensic Readiness, and Financial Crime Investigation in Nigeria. He has published several other articles in reputable journals. He is regularly featured as a subject matter expert on BBC International, Forbes, and many others. He is a Fellow of the Nigeria Society of Engineers and an Official Member of the Forbes technology Council.

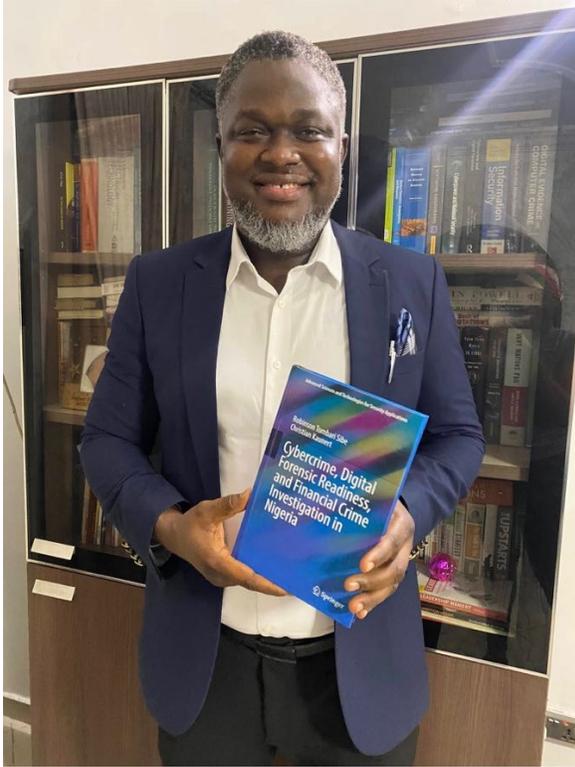
