With more than 40 years of solid experience in business and in communications & information technology, Eng. Helmy lead numerous executive management positions in three Fortune 100 companies, namely NCR/AT&T and Oracle in the United States, Europe, Middle East, and Africa, reaching the positions of Managing Director of NCR UAE, Managing Director of Oracle Egypt, and Chairman of Orange Egypt where he has these Organizations to tremendous success both in business and social impact. Eng Helmy contributed to the development of the digital society in Egypt and MEA as chairman of the Chamber of Communications & Information Technology, member of the American Chamber of commerce, founding member of the Arab Digital Economy Federation, Senior Advisor, Orange MEA and Ambassador of Orange to Smart Africa and through numerous positions on the Board of Directors and Board of Trustees of many organizations, institutions, universities, and NGOs.

In January 2013, Eng. Ate Helmy assumed responsibility as Egypt's Minister of Communications and Information Technology, where he chaired the Boards of the National Telecommunications Regulatory Authority (NTRA), the Information Technology Industry Development Agency (ITIDA), and the National Telecommunication Institute (NTI). Eng. Helmy was responsible for Egypt's transformation into the global digital economy, as envisioned in the National ICT Strategy 2013-2020.

In recognition of his efforts, professionalism and leadership, Eng. Helmy has chaired the World Summit for Information Societies (WSIS +10) high-level event in Geneva in June 2014 and was awarded the Golden Medallion from the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) for his active role in the developing countries specially Africa

In June 2015, the ACUD has recognized Egypt Digital Transformation Strategy as a role model for the Developing Countries.

In June 2017, Eng Atef has been nominated as the President of the General Assembly of Arab Federation for the Digital Economy responsible for the Membership and the Digital Transformation Strategy of the Arab World that was launched in Abu Dhabi in December 2018 under the patronage of HH Sheikh Mohamed Ben Zayied, Crown Prince, and the presence and support HH Shiekh Sief Ben Zayied, Deputy PM and Minister of Interior UAE.

Eng Helmy has supported many African Organizations in Africa including the African Union, Smart Africa and the African Development Bank and participated in many events and conferences to promote the Digital Transformation of Africa
